

Cook County Board of Corrections Meeting
April 28, 2006

The April 28th meeting could not go forward due to the fact that only two Board members, Munir Muhammad and Esequiel Iracheta, were present.

However, The Directors' Report was available to those who were present. The report indicated the following as of 8 a.m. of the morning of April 28, 2006:

The inmate population in Divisions I through 11 totaled 8,983; an additional 2063 defendants were on community supervision and intervention; 115 women were housed in the Women Justice Services Department at the Old Cermak Hospital; 148 were on Sheriff's Female Furlough; and 14 pregnant women were housed at Haymarket drug treatment facility. 17 inmates were hospitalized outside of the corrections compound. During the week, 343 males and 34 females had been sent to other correctional facilities.
